TITLE

Title of the synopsis should be less than 20 words (optimum 15 words)

Title of the synopsis given on page one should be the same as given on page second

ABSRACT

Clearly states and includes

- The objective of the study
- Brief methodology
- Statistical approach/techniques
- Around 250-350 words

INTRODUCTION

Clearly states and includes

- The problem/process for which the study is planned
- Importance of topic
- Justification of the research conducted/need for the research
- Support it with previous research (literature), if available
- Uniform style of citation (Follow APA style)
- Write it like an interesting story
- Review the most relevant studies to your topic
- Hypothesis should be clearly stated (if required)
- Objectives of the research should be at the end of introduction

REVIEW OF LITERATURE

Relevant to the proposed study and properly updated by including the following points:

- What kind of work has been done before on the topic of your study?
- Should be written in some meaningful sequence (story writing) or in chronological order
- Uniform style of citation (Follow APA style)

MATERIALS AND METHODS

Clearly mention

- Location of the experiment
- Experimental design
- Data collection along with units and sampling
- Detail of experimental units and treatments
- Dependent and independent variables
- Husbandry practices (if applicable)
- Survey data according to survey standards (if applicable)
- Procedures/Lab analysis/techniques/tools
- Statistical methods
- Treatment comparison test (if applicable)
- Statistical/analytical references

REFERENCES/ LITERATURE CITED

- Names (Spell) and Year of publication should be same in text and reference list
- Reference list should be arranged alphabetically
- No duplicate reference should be present in reference list
- Follow APA style for references

Format Style

- Margins throughout text should be mirrored (1 inch top, 1 inch bottom, 1.25 inches inside and 1 inch outside)
- Line spacing should be 1.5
- Text style should be Times New Romans
- Font size should be 12
- Text alignment should be Justified
